



Honorary Degrees

Doctor of Engineering

John A. Bizal, M.D. Tri-State Ear, Nose and Throat Surgeons, Incorporated Evansville, Indiana

John Bizal has distinguished himself during a 35-year career as an ear, nose and throat surgeon. He has been honored as a fellow in the American College of Surgery, the American Academy of Facial, Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, and the Head and Neck Society.

Following graduation with honors from Rose-Hulman in 1957, Bizal worked for the Dow Chemical Co., and completed a tour of duty with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prior to entering Indiana University where he earned a master's of business administration. A longtime interest in medicine led to a medical degree from Indiana University. He entered private medical practice in 1970 in Evansville.

He has served as a trustee of the Indiana State Medical Association and is past president of the Indiana State Medical Association. Bizal has been medical director of the Evansville Surgery Center and a past president of the Vanderburgh County Medical Society. He served as a lieutenant colonel in the Army Medical Corps until 1996.

Doctor of Engineering

Walter S. Blackburn
President
Blackburn Associates Architects
Indianapolis, Indiana

Widely regarded as a prominent architect, Walter Blackburn was chosen to design the new Underground Railroad Freedom Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. The museum is the largest and most significant African-American cultural and historical museum in the United States.

Blackburn has worked on an impressive list of important structures in Indiana and across the nation. They include the United Airlines Maintenance Hub at Indianapolis International Airport, the sculpture and ceramic building for the Herron School of Art, and numerous shopping centers, churches, schools, complex housing developments and high-rise buildings.

He is a graduate of the Howard University School of Architecture and Engineering. Blackburn has served as vice president of the American Institute of Architects. He was appointed by President George Bush to the Board of Directors of the National Institute of Building Sciences. He received an honorary degree from Purdue University earlier this month.

Blackburn has served since 1990 as a member of the Rose-Hulman Board of Trustees.

Doctor of Engineering

Harold D. Brown, Jr.
Retired Senior Vice President AMR Energy Corporation and President of Woodacre Corporation
Dallas, Texas

Hal Brown has provided financial and management leadership resulting in substantial growth of several businesses. He has served as president of Woodacre Corp., Amcar, Inc., Dixie Lime and Stone Co., Tonk Products, and Round Rock Lime Co. Brown was senior vice president for finance and administration of AMR Energy Corp., an oil and gas company owned by American Airlines.

After graduating from Rose-Hulman in 1957 with a chemical engineering degree, Brown completed active duty as an officer in the Army Corps of Engineers and was hired by Dow Chemical Co. His work at Dow included positions as area superintendent and production superintendent in Freeport, Texas.

As president of Round Rock Lime Co., Brown restored profitability to the company in just one year. He was instrumental in the acquisition of Tonk Products and Dixie Lime and Stone Co. by Amcar, a subsidiary of Carmuese of Belgium. Brown assisted the Environmental Protection Agency in drafting rules and regulations relating to reformulated gasoline now used in 40 percent of the nation's vehicles.

Brown is the chairman of the business administration committee and treasurer of the Rose-Hulman Board of Trustees.

Doctor of Science

Gail F. Burrill

Director, Mathematical Science Education Board of the National Research Council and Past President, National Council of Teachers of Mathematics Washington, D.C.

Gail Burrill is nationally known as a leader in the field of mathematics education. She has made significant contributions to improvements in the preparation of mathematics teachers and mathematics education. Burrill serves on numerous national and international educational advisory boards related to teaching standards, mathematics curricula and testing.

For 30 years, Burrill taught mathematics at Whitnall High School in Wisconsin. During that time, she received the Presidential Award for Excellence in Teaching Mathematics and Sciences, the Distinguished Mathematics Education Award, and the Rose-Hulman Outstanding High School Teacher Award.

She has served as an associate researcher for the Wisconsin Center for Education Research at the University of Wisconsin in Madison, and serves on the executive committees of the Conference Board on Mathematical Sciences and the International Mathematical Olympics. As the director of the Mathematical Science Education Board, she brings together leaders from various professions to improve mathematics education.

He has appeared on many national broadcast news programs and been quoted by various national business publications.

Davidson's investment banking efforts, Jansen was chief executive officer and co-founder of Palo Alto Technologies, a start-up company focused on developing specialized manufacturing automation systems. He was also the founding partner of the financial advisory firm of Jansen, Remmers, Nichols and Bernier, Inc.

He earned an electrical engineering degree from Rose-Hulman in 1978 and the MBA from Indiana University in 1981. He is a member of the Rose-Hulman Board of Trustees.

Doctor of Engineering

John N. Royse Retired Chairman and CEO Old National Bancorp Terre Haute, Indiana

John Royse has been a leader in the banking profession during a 38-year career with American Fletcher National Bank, Merchants National Bank and Old National Bancorp in Indiana.

Royse began his career in 1960 with American Fletcher National Bank in Indianapolis. Three years later, he joined Merchants National Bank in Terre Haute and held a variety of positions before becoming president in 1977 and chief executive officer in 1979.

Royse was elected to the Old National Bancorp Board of Directors as the result of a merger between Merchants National Bank and Old National in 1985. He became president and chief operating officer in 1991, and chairman and chief executive officer in 1995. Royse retired from Old National Bancorp in 1998 and continues to serve on its Board of Directors.

A Terre Haute native, Royse is a graduate of Amherst College and the University of Wisconsin School of Banking. He is a dedicated volunteer who has served on many community boards, including the United Way, Boy Scouts, Chamber of Commerce, Union Hospital and Indiana State University.

He has been a member of the Rose-Hulman Board of Trustees since 1975 and is the past treasurer of the board.

THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

In today's academic processsion, the gown and hood indicate the degree held by the wearer. The hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree. Graduates of certain institutions wear gowns in the color of the university, although black is the basic color of the majority of academic gowns. The doctor's gown is faced down the front with velvet panels and has three velvet crossbars on each sleeve. The velvet may be black or may be the color which represents the field in which the degree was conferred.

RHIT Bachelor's Degree Attire

Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology Bachelor's degree holders or candidates wear a black gown and a black mortarboard with a red and white tassel.

RHIT Master's Degree Attire

Master's degree hoods for Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology are black, lined with rose satin and white satin chevron and edged in golden yellow velvet. With the gown and hood is worn a black mortarboard with red and white tassel.
